measures of the structure process and outcomes of interventions and 5 establish methods for successfully implementing and sustaining these interventions in regular practice including the training of providers of these interventions the recommendations offered in this report are intended to assist policy makers health care organizations and payers that are organizing and overseeing the provision of care for mental health and substance use disorders while navigating a new health care landscape the recommendations also target providers professional societies funding agencies consumers and researchers all of whom have a stake in ensuring that evidence based high quality care is provided to individuals receiving mental health and substance use services
